I am writing to you today to introduce Byron Chae, *Associate Director* of Fellowship International. The international mission's department of The Fellowship of Evangelical Baptist Churches in Canada. You may have heard of Byron, or about the initiatives he oversees in Canada; which is to engage Fellowship Churches and to coordinate some Fellowship International missionaries to catalyze movements of disciple making across our nation.

Byron is eminently qualified to do this work. While he served with Power to Change as *Regional Director*, he saw the need for and initiated a ministry serving 2nd generation Asian Canadian students. The ministry reached out to beyond Asian background students, and it resulted in hundreds of students reaffirming their faith, coming to faith, being trained in leadership and reaching into the community both on campuses and in the wider communities surrounding those campuses.

Byron is well acquainted with church life having served as a pastor in churches, as well as currently an elder of Springvale Baptist Church, a Fellowship Baptist Church in Stouffville, Ontario.

I am deeply grateful for Byron's godly character and his unwavering commitment to the global mission to go and make disciples of all nations. Due to his efforts, we have witnessed a surge in recruitment (22 new missionary appointments), a significant shift in mission emphasis to establish 'disciple making churches' among the 22 fields our missionaries serve, and building strong partnerships with many of our local churches and over a dozen new International Agencies. I'm grateful to labour for the Kingdom alongside someone who is so passionate and innovative like Byron.

Byron, like all our Fellowship International staff, is required to raise a significant amount of personal support, thereby serving our churches, our Fellowship International missionaries here and abroad, and our National Fellowship at minimal cost.

It is my hope that in meeting Byron you will consider either direct support through your Church, and if that is not possible to introduce him to individuals within your congregation who have potential interest in financially supporting him directly.

Thank you for considering this request, to meet and support Byron Chae. I am praying with you to the Lord of Harvest, so that more will be won for Christ, both here and abroad.
